

COOMERA: A GROWING CENTRE

THIS BLOSSOMING AREA OF
THE GOLD COAST WILL SEE

Works on Stage 2 of the Gold Coast Light Rail have begun and an additional 3 stations added to the light rail network will bring Southern Gold Coast closer than ever before. Connection to the Light Rail from Coomera is only 6 minutes by heavy rail. This will provide fast connection to the new Gold Coast University Hospital and Private hospital. Stage two of the Gold Coast light rail will see a direct public transport link from Coomera to Southport, Main Beach, Surfer's Paradise and beyond.

There are 11 primary and secondary schools located close to Bloom, Coomera with a range of excellent education providers. Also within close reach is the \$26 million Coomera Creative TAFE campus and the new \$40 million sports and leisure complex, scheduled for completion for the 2018 Commonwealth Games.

The \$1.5 billion Coomera Town Centre will set a benchmark for an increase in commercial, retail and residential development across the Northern Gold Coast. Whether you are searching for the latest must have-item or an extra special gift the new Westfield Coomera Town Centre will have a range of speciality shops that will cater to your every need. The Coomera Town Centre will result in 3,300 new jobs upon completion.

Coomera is well on the way to becoming a self-sufficient regional centre, with excellent public transport links, education, retail, recreation and employment opportunities.






COOMERA: THEN & NOW

1865

The Coomera River is a crucial trade route for loggers and hinterland farmers. Families start to settle the area.

The ford at Upper Coomera becomes the crossing point for the Brisbane-Nerang mail route.

The introduction of the ferry confirms the importance of this North-South crossing.

1885

A Governor of Queensland, Governor Musgrave, built a seaside home near Southport in 1885, setting a trend for the coast becoming a fashionable resort for the wealthy and influential

1889

In 1889, a train line was extended from Brisbane to Southport, later extending down to Coolangatta..

1925

A new coastal road, linking Brisbane to the beaches of the coast was completed in 1925.

1930

The original Coomera Bridge opens.

South Coast Rail Line runs through Lower Coomera. A railway station here confirms permanent settlement.

Late 1940

Brisbane journalists start to refer to the coastline south of Brisbane as the Gold Coast: the place to buy and sell land in the post-war real estate boom.

The local council begins to realise this name is a great promotional asset.

1958

The South Coast Town Council adopts the name Gold Coast Town Council.

1959

Oueensland State Government officially proclaims the Local Authority of the City of the Gold Coast on 16 May 1959.

1980

The Place Names Board of Queensland officially gazettes the name Gold Coast in April 1980.
