About Brassall

Brassall is a suburb of Ipswich, Queensland, Australia.

Brassall is located within the Brisbane metropolitan area. The origin of the suburb name is unknown. Was also known as Hungry Flats, as was a stop over for bullock teams that were transporting logs from Pine Mountain to Hancocks saw mill at North Ipswich. It was named by an early surveyor by the name of James Warner although he never gave its meaning or origin. Brassall was a separate shire with its own council from March 1860 until 1 January 1917 when the area became part of Ipswich. The suburb was officially bounded and named in 1991.

Brassall Bikeway



The very popular Brassall Bikeway links North Ipswich, Brassall, Wulkuraka and the Brisbane Valley Rail Trail - which continues onto Fernvale and stretches all the way to Yarraman. The Bikeway is also a popular spot for families on the weekend, with the final stage completed in late 2016.

The Brassall Bikeway is a 14km bike path that highlights the region's history, as it's aligned with the first railway line built in Queensland. It's fully paved and is a very safe environment for all, wayfinding signs around the length are impressive.

There is also a 600metre mountain bike track you can access from the Bikeway if you're felling adventurous. The track has a bike repair station and shaded seat for spectators. The trail is perfect for all ages although training wheels are not recommended.

Discover the old steam engine, railway siding and other surprises along the way as you wind your way along the bike path. Visit the heritage listed The Workshops Rail Museum, or take the kids out to the bicycle learning track at Sutton Park
